HOW TO REDEEM YOUR VOUCHER

PAPERWORK REQUIRED

Once you have redeemed your voucher you will receive a confirmation email which will contain the following forms which you will need to complete and bring with you on the day of your skydive..

UK Parachuting Student Indemnity – You have to be over 16 to skydive in the UK and if you are under 18 on the day of your skydive you will need a parent or guardian to sign the form.

BPA Form 115A Tandem student parachutist medical information and declaration - This is a self declaration and does not require a GPs signature.

IMPORTANT NOTICES: WEIGHT AND HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

The weight limit for parachute jumps at our Sibson drop zone is 15.5st (98.43kg) for men and 15.0st (95.25kg) for women. At our Beccles drop zone it is 17st (108kg) for men and 15.7st (99.7kg) for women. There is no height limit for Skydiving, however your weight should be in proportion to your height.

Terms and Conditions

The term 'skydive' applies to any type of parachute descent. 1. UK Parachuting will make every effort to comply with the preferred dates for booking. If the dates are unavailable, UK Parachuting will contact you prior to your attendance to arrange an alternative. 2. Bookings are made on the understanding that any skydive will only take place in accordance with the safety guidelines imposed by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) and the British Parachute Association (BPA). 3. A booking, once made, is final and the date cannot be changed with less than 14 days notice. An administration fee of £30 will be charged for changing the date once agreed. 4. The balance of payment is due on or before the day of the course. Any fee(s) or deposit(s) paid are non-refundable. 5. If you fail to turn up on the day of the course (irrespective of reason or cause), you will not be permitted to a refund of any fee(s) or deposit(s) paid or be permitted to commute any fees paid towards another course on another date. You will still be liable for the balance of payment. 6. If inclement weather or technical problems with the aircraft or instructors prevents skydiving on the day booked, you will be able to rebook a mutually convenient date free of charge. Refunds will not be made under these circumstances. 7. Due to irregularities in weather, aircraft limitations and numbers of participants on the day of the course, you may need to be at the drop zone for the entire day, irrespective of your arrival time. For AFF courses, it may be necessary for the jump to take place at a later date following the ground training. 8. On the day of the course, if you do not conform to the age, weight and health requirements of the CAA and the BPA, or you do not have the correct paperwork required for skydiving (see above), you will not be permitted to take part in any skydive and the balance of payment will still be due. 9. When booking in a group, you accept responsibility for these terms on behalf of all participating members of the group. If a group booking has been made and some of the group fails to turn up, the non-group price will be charged. 10. Any vouchers purchased are non-refundable, and are not valid beyond the expiry date. To transfer the voucher to another person there is an administration charge of £30. 11. To extend a booking or a voucher for 3 months there is an administration charge of £49 per person. 12. All standard terms and conditions apply to bookings made to redeem vouchers. 13. Once a date has been booked to redeem a voucher, if the participant does not turn up the voucher will be deemed to have been used.
